Prickett’s Fort State Park in Fairmont, West Virginia, was started through tremendous volunteer initiative in 1974, 200 years after the original Pricketts Fort was built. The park opened to the public in 1976. The Fort represents one of 100 civilian refuge forts that existed within a thirty mile radius. The facilities include a Visitor Center, the reconstructed fort, a restored 1859 home, a barn, outdoor amphitheater, and various recreational opportunities. The Visitor Center houses a gallery with an orientation exhibition area. The fort and house display collections in furnished period rooms. In addition to architecture and collections, the site presents living history interpretation through costumed staff who demonstrate 18th and 19th century pioneer life and culture to visitors.

In addition to demonstrating daily life, interpreters take visitors on a guided tour of the Fort and the Job Prickett House and present daily specialized talks on topics

within their area of expertise. Tours and talks are scheduled at regular intervals throughout each day during open season.
