



HOW TO SCHEDULE YOUR SCHOOL FIELD TRIP

To schedule a visit for your school please call Pricketts Fort at (304) 363-3030 or email info@prickettsfort.org. The Fort staff can help you to plan a trip that focuses on the areas that are most relevant to your course goals and objectives as well as the age level of your students. The school tour starts with an introduction to the history of the fort and then small groups visit several stations which demonstrate a particular aspect of Fort Life. Living history interpreters provide an exciting and experiential lesson for students.

We recommend that you begin your pre-visit activities using the Pricketts Fort curriculum materials available here. On-site teacher-led activities as well as post-visit activities are included in the curriculum and time can be allowed for them following your visit to the Fort.

Field trips can be planned for the fall or spring or fall semester. Generally a tour lasts between one and a half and two hours. Picnic tables are available in the park and many schools pack a lunch to have before or after their tour. Students also enjoy the museum shop and educational items are available in a wide price range.
