



PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT

The photo scavenger hunt is an activity designed to heighten students' awareness of their surroundings while visiting Prickett's Fort. The basic activity is to give students a camera and a list of items they will see at the fort. The students are to find the items and take a picture of that item. Here are two suggestions of how this project can be approached.

Give the students a list of items and assign them each one item. Assign one student to be the photographer and another to be the recorder. When the other students identify the item they were to find, they will inform the photographer and recorder. The photographer will then take a picture of the item and the recorder will make a record of the completion that item. This suggestion would be most effective if the school has a digital camera that can be used on the visit.

Break the students into groups of four or five. Assign each group a disposable camera and a list of items they will see at the fort. Each group is responsible for finding those items and taking a picture of the items with the members of the group. Each student is expected to appear in pictures with some of the items so the camera must be shared.
